# PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Good afternoon my dear FINEX members, officers, and guests to this general afternoon's membership meeting. I hope all of you are having a productive week. It is not usual that we hold our GMM on a Friday but it is great to see all of you here and I hope you'll find our meeting today very the economic interesting given briefing and discussions we will be having.

As mentioned, this is our 11th Regular GMM, I would like to thank the Professional Development Committee and the Programs and Meetings Committee of FINEX for putting our line-up of speakers and panelist together. I'm looking forward to hearing from Jonas Ravelas, Rob Carnell, and Richard Heydarian. I know that some of you in attendance are still in the middle or tail-end of your budgeting process. Let's see if any of the information to be shared today will affect any of your figures.

Most of our time today will be spent on Philippine matters. This being the case, I would like to share economic insights we have been monitoring and developments we expect to see from the region and the world.

The growing geopolitical uncertainty (yes it is still growing!) and inflationary pressures are expected to take their toll on global economic growth projections.

On a global scale, we at KPMG are forecasting a GDP growth of 1.9 percent in 2023, down from 2.7 percent in 2022, as the world grapples with a multitude of economic and political challenges. Weaker growth could see inflation go down to 4.7 percent in 2023 after averaging 7.6 percent in 2022.

At present, an expected acceleration in inflation is putting pressure on households' finances and businesses' margins, which in turn leads central banks to tighten monetary policy aggressively, with recession once again on the horizon in many economies. Talks about recession have been in place since early this year, it is good that we have not entered into an actual recession.
