Commissioner, <u>Bureau of Internal Revenue</u>

- Commissioner Romeo "Jun" D. Lumagui, Jr., is a tax lawyer who obtained his Juris Doctor degree at the Ateneo de Manila University School of Law, graduating with Second Honors.
- He is a public servant of the Bureau of Internal Revenue, having served in various capacities in its Operations and Legal Groups. He has served as Deputy Commissioner for Operations Group and Chief of Regional Investigation Division. He was also a Technical Assistant to the Commissioner.
- Concurrently, he headed taskforces aimed at boosting collections for the country's coffers. He headed several taskforces, such as Assets Recovery Task Force, where total collections amounted to Php833.69 million, and Task Force on Direct Selling/Multi-Level Marketing and Investment Scams, where assessments totaled to Php792.56 million both in just a span of around one year.
- He is also a member of the Special Disciplinary Committee specially created by the former BIR Commissioner to discipline erring revenue officials

An Art-Filled Morning at the Ateneo Art Gallery

Led by FINEX Arts & Culture Committee Chairperson Atty. Lia Picazo-San Juan and Liaison Director Domingo Go, 34 attendees composed of FINEX members, their family and friends visited the Ateneo Art Gallery one fine morning last February 4, 2023.

Kicking off the maiden project of the FINEX Arts & Culture Committee for 2023, the participants were treated to a private guided tour of the museum and its outdoor art installations.

A feast for the eyes were the current exhibits highlighting the works of various National Artists from an impressive collection of historian Ambeth Ocampo, which boasted works by Arturo Luz, Benedicto Cabrera, Napoleon Abueva and Jose Joya, among other giants of the visual arts.

Also on view was a collection of donated art pieces from various collectors and philanthropists with close ties to the Ateneo. The collection, consisting of contemporary works by masters such as Imelda Cajipe-Endaya, Federico Alcuaz, Galo Ocampo, and Lee Aguinaldo, is considered one of the finest in the country.

"Dark Memories: Torture, Incarceration,
Disappearance and Death During Martial Law" found
the group profoundly soul searching in quiet
reflection on the suffering during that unfortunate

era. A highlight of the tour, this exhibit is not to be missed.

The third-floor gallery meanwhile showcases budding artists, winners of the Ateneo Arts Awards.

Outdoors by the amphitheater, the group viewed installation works "Islands for Sale" by Pete Jimenez, "Ang Mamatay ng Dahil Sa Iyo" by Archie Oclos and, a humongous alien-like bamboo structure with vegetable gardens within entitled "Mebuyan's Colony" by Leroy New.

The Ateneo Art Gallery is a university museum located inside the Areté building of the Ateneo de Manila University. Established in 1960, it is widely recognized today as the first museum of Philippine modern art.
